

**Duties
 Authorised by
 Certificate**

The holder of this certificate can:

- (a) command and operate engines of a vessel <12 m long that is not carrying passengers:
- (i) in sheltered waters or within 5 nm from point of departure, shore base or aquaculture lease; and
 - (ii) with propulsion power:
 - for an inboard engine - <100 kW unless endorsed to <500 kW inboard propulsion; or
 - for an outboard engine – unlimited
- (b) command and operate the engines of a vessel that is not carrying passengers (unless they hold a current First Aid certificate):
- (i) as a tender or auxiliary vessel within 3 nm of a parent vessel in the EEZ; and
 - (ii) with propulsion power:
 - for an inboard engine - <100 kW unless endorsed to <500 kW inboard propulsion; or
 - for an outboard engine - unlimited

USI

If you're studying nationally recognised training in Australia from 1 January 2015, you will be required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). Your USI links to an online account that contains all your training records and results (transcript) that you have completed from 1 January 2015 onwards. **What to
 bring**

Identification: A current Australian Driver's Licence or Passport.

For the Classroom: Wear closed in shoes; bring pens, pencils, eraser.

Meals: Please bring your own lunch or use a cafe nearby. Coffee, tea and biscuits are supplied.

To complete the Coxswain Grade 2 qualification, you will need to complete the Survive at Sea and Fire Warden courses, unless you already have a current **Shipboard Safety Skill Set Statement of Attainment or Certificate of Safety Training (CoST)**. Please provide the original of these certificates to SMIT as we will require a copy as evidence.

SMIT offers the Survive at Sea course. It is delivered over two days and the cost is \$550.00.

ECB Training Services and Territory Fire Service & Training are local organisations that offer Fire Warden training.

You will need to obtain a **Short Range Operators Certificate of Proficiency** (VHF Marine Radio license) if a VHF Radio is used on your vessel. SMIT offers this one-day course for a cost of \$250.00. You will need to supply a Passport-sized photo.

After completing and passing your Qualification with SMIT, and if all prerequisites are met, SMIT will issue an Interim Certificate of Competency which will be valid until you receive your final Certificate of Competency from AMSA. To apply for your final Certificate of Competency, you must submit a Certificate of Competency Application and other forms and evidence through an approved Australia Post Centre.
