

<p>Course Description</p>	<p>The Radar Certificate of Competency is a required unit of competency for the qualification MAR30918 Certificate III in Maritime Operations (Master up to 24 metres Near Coastal). It is recommended that the candidate has knowledge of Coastal Navigation prior to commencing.</p> <p>At the end of the course, the candidate will be able to demonstrate knowledge of fundamentals of radar and ability in the operation and use of radar, and in the interpretation and analysis of information obtained from the equipment, including</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Factors affecting performance and accuracy 2. Setting up and maintaining displays 3. Detection of misrepresentation of information, false echoes, sea return, etc. 4. Range and bearing 5. Identification of critical echoes 6. Application of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 7. Basic understanding of use of radar for navigation and collision avoidance
