

<p>Duties Authorised by Certificate</p>	<p>The holder of this certificate can act as:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Chief Engineer on a vessel with propulsion power <500 kW, in the Exclusive economic Zone (EEZ); Second Engineer on a vessel with propulsion power <750 kW, in the EEZ Chief Engineer or Second Engineer on a vessel with an outboard engine with unlimited propulsion in waters to the outer limits of the EEZ Assist an engineer in any tasks that may be required on board while working under the direct supervision of the person in charge of the vessel's engines Work in the engine room of a vessel <80 m long with propulsion power <3000 kW.
<p>USI</p>	<p>If you're studying nationally recognised training in Australia from 1 January 2015, you will be required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). Your USI links to an online account that contains all your training records and results (transcript) that you have completed from 1 January 2015 onwards. <p>Enrolment Process</p>	<p>The enrolment form may be downloaded from SMIT's website, completed electronically and then emailed to admin@smitech.com.au, or printed. Forms are also available at reception. Your enrolment form, USI and payment are to be submitted to SMIT before the commencement of the course.</p>
<p>Course Requirements</p>	<p>Duration 5 days 8:00 am to 4:00 pm weekdays</p> <p>Cost \$750.00</p>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A deposit of \$200.00 is required before the first day of the course. Full payment of course fees is required before or on commencement of the course. Under certain circumstances, SMIT staff will discuss and agree on a payment plan with the student. A Qualification Certificate, AMSA Mandated Practical Assessment or Interim Certificate of Competency will not be issued until the full fees have been paid. When an employer is paying for the student to complete a course, a Purchase Order is required by the employer before the course commencement. A deposit is not required. An invoice for payment will be issued to the employer at the commencement of a course. Payment terms are 14 days. Fees may be paid by Credit Card at the reception or over the phone, by cash or by Bank Transfer. SMIT guarantees a full refund of monies paid if the student does not commence attendance of the course, or if SMIT cancels the course. SMIT reserves the right to cancel a course if the numbers do not meet the minimum requirement to commence the program. <p>What to bring</p> <p>Identification: A current Australian Driver's Licence or Passport.</p> <p>For the Classroom: Enclosed footwear must be worn; bring pens, pencils, eraser.</p> <p>Meals: Please bring your own lunch or use a cafe nearby. <p>First Aid Certificate</p>	<p>A HLTAID003 - Provide first aid or equivalent is required. Please provide the original certificate to SMIT for evidence.</p>

Final AMSA Certificate

To complete the Marine Engine Driver Grade 3 qualification, you will need to complete the Survive at Sea and Fire Warden courses, unless you already have a current **Shipboard Safety Skill Set Statement of Attainment or Certificate of Safety Training (CoST)**. Please provide the original of these certificates to SMIT as we will require a copy as evidence.

SMIT offers the Survive at Sea course. It is delivered over two days and the cost is \$550.00.

Territory Fire Service & Training and ECB Training are local organisations that offer Fire Warden training.

After completing and passing your Qualification with SMIT, and if all prerequisites are met, SMIT may issue an Interim Certificate of Competency. This will be valid until you receive your final Certificate of Competency from AMSA. To apply for your final Certificate of Competency, you must submit a Certificate of Competency Application and other forms and evidence through an approved Australia Post Centre.
