

LROCP – Long Range Operator’s Certificate of Proficiency (HF)	<p>This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to transmit and receive information by marine radio on board a commercial vessel including using marine very high frequency (VHF) and high frequency (HF) radio according to regulations</p> <p>Unit of Competency studied: MARC043 – Transmit and receive information by marine radio (Release 1)</p>
SROCP – Short Range Operator’s Certificate of Proficiency (VHF)	<p>VHF radio on a commercial vessel according to regulations, including carrying out user-maintenance and fault-finding; operating an (EPIRB), a search and rescue radar transponder (SART) and AIS search and rescue transmitter (AIS-SART)), automatic identification system man overboard (AIS-MOB) device, and digital selective calling man overboard (DSC-MOB) device.</p> <p>Unit of Competency studied: MARC044 - Transmit and receive information by marine VHF radio (Release 1)</p>
<p>Both units are included in the current Maritime Training Package Version 5.0.</p>	
Course Structure	<p>The Marine Radio course content is delivered by SMIT Trainers who are qualified Invigilators. They will supervise your written exam and conduct a practical assessment. Your exams are then mailed to the Office of Marine Communications at the Australian Maritime College for marking and issue of the Certificate.</p>
USI	<p>If you're studying nationally recognised training in Australia from 1 January 2015, you will be required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). Your USI links to an online account that contains all your training records and results (transcript) that you have completed from 1 January 2015 onwards. Go to https://www.usi.gov.au/students for more information.</p>
Enrolment Process	<p>The enrolment form may be downloaded from SMIT’s website, completed electronically and then emailed to admin@smitech.com.au, or printed. Forms are also available at reception. Your enrolment form, USI and payment are to be submitted to SMIT before the commencement of the course.</p>
Course Requirements	<p>The minimum age for the issue of a Certificate of Proficiency is 16 years old.</p> <p>Class times: 8:00 am to 4:00 pm</p>
What to Bring	<p>You are asked to bring photo ID and supply a passport-sized photo which will be sent to the Australian Maritime College with your exam for marking and issue of the Certificate.</p> <p>Tea, coffee and biscuits are supplied. Please bring your own lunch or visit a nearby café.</p>
Course Costs and Duration	<p>The Long Range Operator’s Certificate of Proficiency course is scheduled over two days, but may be completed in one day in some circumstances. The cost is \$350.</p> <p>The Short Range Operator’s Certificate of Proficiency course is delivered in one day, and the cost is \$250.</p> <p>The Handbook, the cost of the exam submission and issue of the certificate are included in the above costs.</p> <p>Payment Terms and Conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full payment of course fees is required before or on commencement of the course. • Under certain circumstances, SMIT staff will discuss and agree on a payment plan with the student. • Your exam will not be sent to AMC for marking and issue of certificate until the full fees have been paid. • When an employer is paying for the student to complete a course, a Purchase Order is required by the employer before the course commencement. • An invoice for payment will be issued to the employer at the commencement of a course. Payment terms are 14 days. • Fees may be paid by Credit Card at the reception or over the phone, by cash or by Bank Transfer. • SMIT guarantees a full refund of monies paid if the student does not commence attendance of the course, or if SMIT cancels the course. • SMIT reserves the right to cancel a course if the numbers do not meet the minimum requirement to commence the program.
